Teaching of the Church

- "Homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered" (*CCC*, 2357)
- "Must be accepted with respect, compassion, and sensitivity" (CCC, 2358)
- "Homosexual persons are called to chastity" (*CCC*, 2359)
- "They can and should gradually and resolutely approach Christian perfection" (CCC, 2359)
