#### Rouen

##### Journey along Medieval Normandy's Abbey Trail

**\$80 USD**

Join a local expert on an exploration of two of the Seine River region's remarkable abbeys, St. Wandrille and Jumièges. First, visit St. Wandrille, which is still a living, working community and home to Benedictine monks. Visit the ruins of the original abbey, which was founded in 649 by St. Wandrille and trained a number of bishops and saints of the church. Listen in as our local expert shares stories of the abbey's great past and explains the architectural elements that can be found in its ruins. Continue on to Jumièges to visit the remains of its immense abbey, originally founded in 654 by Saint Philibert. The abbey was destroyed in 841 by the Vikings and again during the Hundred Years War. However, some of the exterior walls still stand, creating a striking silhouette against the landscape. View the remains of the cloisters, as well as the two church towers that enclose the Romanesque façade. Enjoy some time at leisure to continue exploring the grounds before returning to the ship. This option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 20 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

#### Le Havre

##### Étretat Walking Tour

**\$65 USD**

Located on the coast of Normandy, Étretat is renowned for its stunning coastal scenery and spectacular white cliffs. Begin with a view of the breathtaking scenery of coastal cliffs and rock formations from the clifftop path. Next, enjoy a walking tour of this seaside resort town made popular by the famous authors and artists who were inspired here including Claude Monet, Victor Hugo and Gustave Flaubert. Spend time exploring this small town on your own, from the pebble beach to the promenade. This option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 20 passengers is required. Transportation is not included.

#### Paris

##### Palace of Versailles

**\$125 USD**

Explore the grand private apartments and the splendors of the Hall of Mirrors on a guided tour of the Palace of Versailles. The palace and gardens reflect the elaborate tastes of King Louis XIV, the "Sun King." Louis XIV moved the royal court from Paris to Versailles in 1682 and transformed it from a hunting lodge built by Louis XIII into one of the costliest and most extravagant buildings in the world. This option must be purchased 90 days prior to departure. Only available prior to departure and must be booked at time of final payment. This option will not be available for sale on board the cruise ship. *Duration: Approximately 4 hours.* Please note a minimum of 20 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

##### Montmartre District Walking Tour

**\$65 USD**

Located in the 18th arrondissement, Montmartre offers a splendid panoramic view over the city of Paris. Discover one of Paris' most iconic, artistic districts. Narrow streets wind their way through this community dotted with charming lampposts, steep stairways and cobblestone squares full of artists painting and sketching. Stroll through these charming streets with your local guide, hearing tales of artists such as Picasso, Renoir and Toulouse-Lautrec who have contributed to Montmartre's storied past. This option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 3 hours.* Please note a minimum of 20 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
