YOUTH MINISTER (Grades 9 thru 12)

Position Title: Youth Minister-Grades 9-12

Status: Part-time Hourly

Basic Objectives: To assist the Pastor in his direction of the parish.

Full-Time: August 15 to June 15

Major Duties:

- 1. Identifies the youth of the parish and their needs, concentrates primarily in youth 13-18 years of age in both parochial and public schools; and, meets the needs of and to the unchurched youth of the parish.
- 2. Develops a core of youth (grade 9-12) to provide peer leadership.
- 3. Provides opportunities for formal and informal religious education (23 hours per calendar year) via retreats, bible study, days of recollection, and guest speakers.
- 4. Responsible for the instruction and preparation of youth liturgies, Para liturgies and prayer services and inclusion of appropriate music.
- 5. Coordinates and implements Confirmation Preparation Program.
- 6. Integrates young people into the larger worshipping community via ushering, reading, greeting, Eucharistic Minister and youth choir.
- 7. Present at Sunday evening Liturgy in conjunction with youth involvement.
- 8. Communicates with youth via social media, parish website, and bulletin announcements.
- 9. Raises consciousness of youth toward social and economic problems via Christian Service and community service.
- 10. Plan Senior Thanksgiving Dinner and Mary Celebration with PreK-8 Coordinator.
- 10. Provide Hight School mentoring opportunities with Middle School Youth.
- 11. Plan service opportunities with PreK-8 Coordinator.
- 12. Engage parents and adults in youth program; offer youth/parent communication skills.
- 13. Prepares and submits an annual budget for youth needs; regularly report to Administration and Finance.

- 14. Participates in Parish Stewardship efforts to engage persons in Time, Talent, Prayer and Treasure.
- 15. Assumes responsibilities as delineated via Pastor/Education Commission.
- 16. Cooperates with other parishes in this region/diocese on special projects.
- 17. Offers community building activities, social activities, and spiritual activities.
- 18. Provide an atmosphere of openness, hospitality, Christianity and service to all encountered as a member of St. John Parish Staff.
