And our inmost being fill!

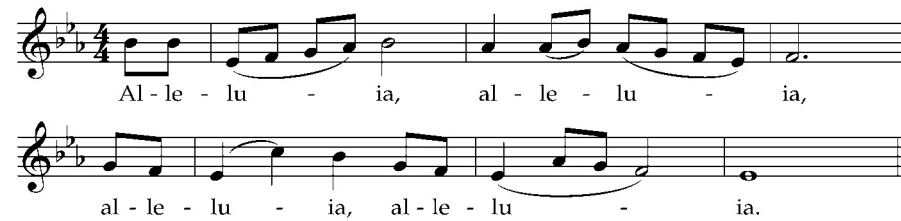
All: Where you are not, we have naught,

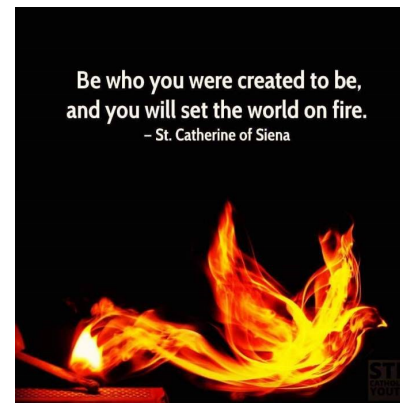


