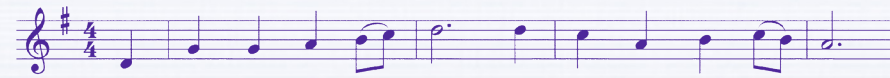

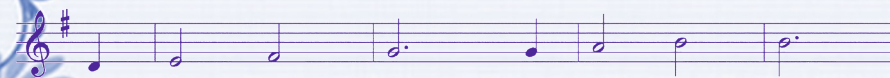
To God with Gladness Sing



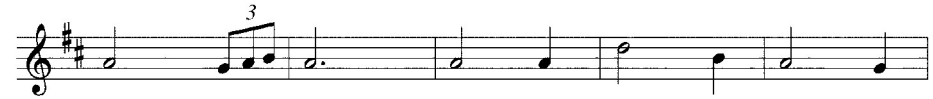
